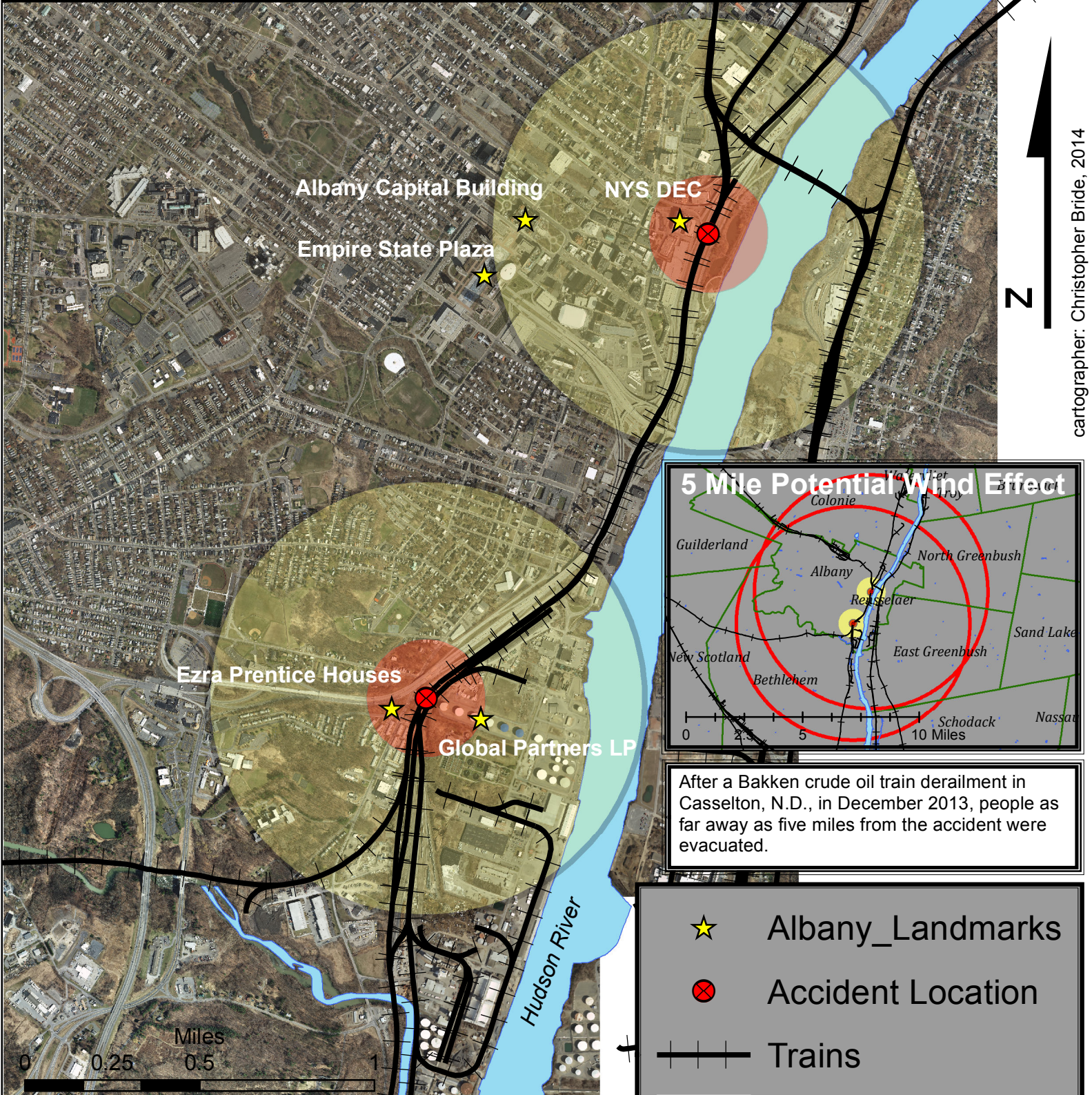


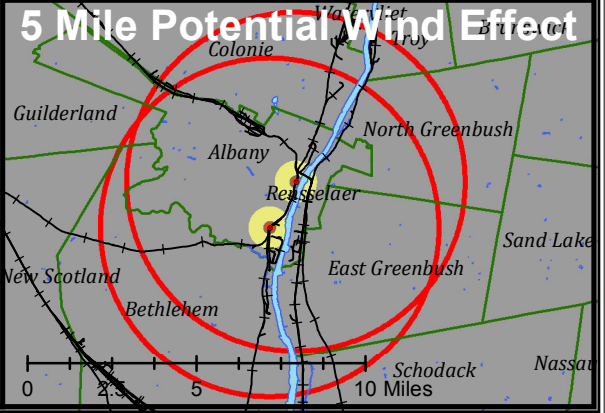
# Albany: What If It Happened Here?

A train carrying Bakken crude oil in Lac-Megantic, Quebec, derailed in July 2013, causing a fire that destroyed buildings 300 yards away, and prompted a 1,100-yard evacuation zone. Forty-seven people died, and 1.5 million gallons of oil spilled, affecting the lake and nearby Chaudiere River.
