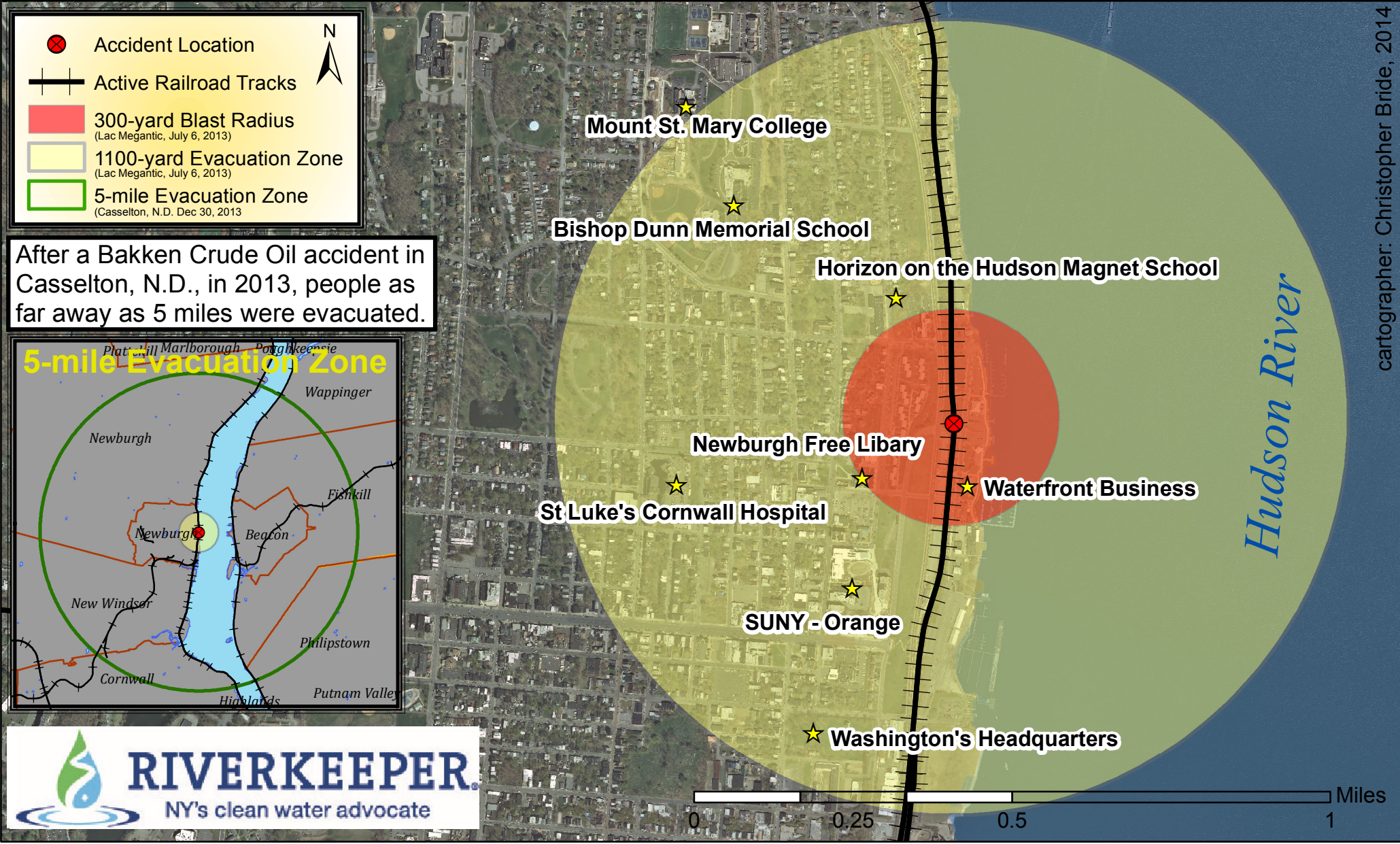


Newburgh: What if it Happened Here?

A train carrying Bakken crude oil derailed in Lac Megantic, Quebec in July, 2013, exploding and killing 47 people in a fire that spread 300 yards, and prompted a 1,100-yard evacuation zone.
